1 | UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE WITH TEACHER LICENSURE

Earn an undergraduate Bachelor of Science degree with teacher licensure! BS Education, Secondary Education, Major in CTE - Agricultural Education. You can dual major in Agricultural Sciences. Transfer options available!

2 | MASTER'S DEGREE WITH TEACHER LICENSURE

First, earn an undergraduate degree in the agricultural content area of your choice. Then, earn a Master's of Science in Career and Technical Education in 10 months while also obtaining a teaching license.

3 | UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE TO ALTERNATIVE LICENSURE

First, earn an undergraduate degree in the agricultural content area of your choice. Then, enter the field by finding a position teaching agriculture in grades 6-12 with a provisional license. Complete 18 credits in professional studies within 3 years.
